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22	The Court finds as follows:
23	A. The Court granted preliminary approval of the Amended
24	Settlement Agreement ("Settlement Agreement") and certified a
20	provisional settlement class on October 18, 2022.
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B. The Court granted final approval of the Settlement Agreement on May 4, 2023, certified the settlement class with no opt-outs, and found that the Settlement Agreement was fair, adequate and reasonable.

C. The Court defined the following:

"Certified Class": all belt sorters employed by BBSI at MRF or DART between April 15, 2011 and September 30, 2013 and, following notice and an opportunity to opt-out, the class includes the individuals listed on Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement. (Settlement Agreement, pg. 1.)

"Aggrieved Employees": all belt sorters employed by BBSI at MRF or DART between October 9, 2011 and September 30, 2013. (Ibid.)

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. Plaintiffs David Kaanaana, Tiffany L. Montoya, And Kathy Canterberry, individuals on behalf of themselves and others similarly situated, shall take from Defendants Barrett Business Services, Inc., Michael J. Alvarez, an individual, as set forth in the Parties' Settlement Agreement and the Court's Approval Order entered May 4, 2023.

2. Defendants must pay Plaintiffs the Gross Settlement Amount (GSA) of \$4,865,000. The Net Settlement Amount is the GSA minus the following:

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1 \$1,621,666.67 for attorney fees to Class Counsel, a. 2 Hayes Pawlenko LLP; 3 \$75,000 for attorney costs to Class Counsel; b. 4 \$10,000 for settlement administration costs to с. 5 CPT Group, Inc.; 6 d. \$22,500 service award to the class 7 representatives, David Kaanaana, Tiffany L. Montoya, and Kathy 8 Canterberry (\$7,500 each); 9 e. \$75,000 (75% of \$100,000 PAGA penalty) to the 10 LWDA. 11 The employer's share of payroll taxes will be paid 12 separately by Defendant in addition to the GSA. 13 3. Upon the Settlement Administrator's disbursement of 14 payments to the members of the "Certified Class", the Certified 15 16 Class shall release BBSI, the Sanitation District and all other 17 County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County and their 18 respective directors, officers, members, employees, agents, 19 attorneys, successors, assigns, and affiliates, and any past, 20 present, or future parent, subsidiary, affiliate, predecessor 21 successor, personal representative or heir, and all agents, 22 employees, officers, directors, and attorneys thereof ("Released 23 Parties") from all "Released Claims" through the date the Court 24 enters an order granting preliminary approval of the Settlement, 25 with "Released Claims" defined as: any and all claims that were

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or could have been pled based on the factual allegations in the 2 operative Third Amended Complaint, including, without 3 limitation, all individual and representative claims for minimum 4 wages, overtime wages, prevailing wages, liquidated damages, 5 interest, meal period premiums, statutory penalties, or any 6 other forms of relief based on the factual allegations in the 7 Third Amended Complaint. (¶3)

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Upon the Settlement Administrator's disbursement of payments to the Aggrieved Employees, the Aggrieved Employees will be deemed to have released the Released Parties from all "Released PAGA Claims" through the date the Court enters an order granting preliminary approval of the Settlement, with "Released PAGA Claims" defined as: any and all PAGA claims that were or could have been pled based on the facts alleged in the notice provided to the Labor & Workforce Development Agency ("LWDA"). (Ibid.)

As of the Effective Date, BBSI shall release the Sanitation District and all other County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County and their respective directors, officers, members, employees, agents, attorneys, successors, assigns, and affiliates from any and claims relating to the "Released Claims" as defined above including without limitation claims under the Labor Code, claims for indemnity and/or contribution, breach of contract, and/or for attorney fees and costs. (Ibid.)

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As of the Effective Date, the Sanitation District and all other County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County and their respective directors, officers, members, employees, agents, attorneys, successors, assigns, and affiliates shall release BBSI and any parent, subsidiary, affiliate, predecessor or successor, and all agents, employees, officers, directors, and attorneys thereof from any and claims relating to the "Released Claims" as defined above. (Ibid.)

4. All uncashed settlement checks, plus interest, must be delivered to the California State Controller's Unclaimed Property Division in the name of the Class Member/Aggrieved Employee who did not cash his or her check.

5. Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h), the Court retains jurisdiction over the parties with respect to enforcement of this Judgment under California Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6.
