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PROPOSED SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE FOR COMPLETING THE FINAL APPROVAL PROCESS

The Settlement Agreement contains a proposed schedule for notice of the Settlement, as follows, which Plaintiff respectfully requests this Court to approve:

- 1) Within thirty (30) calendar days of preliminary approval, defendant will provide the class list to the settlement administrator. In the event defendant fails to provide a complete class list within said 30 calendar days, defendant will provide the class list it has compiled at that time to settlement administrator and then will have fifteen (15) additional calendar days to provide the remainder of the class list to the settlement administrator.
- 2) Within thirty (30) calendar days after receiving the class list from defendant, the settlement administrator will mail a class notice to all class members via regular first-class U.S. mail, using the most current, known mailing addresses identified in the class list.
- 3) The Response Deadline will be extended for fifteen (15) calendar days for all remailed Notices.
- 4) A final approval hearing for June 14, 2024 in Courtroom 6A of the United States Central District of California courthouse, located at 350 West 1st Street, Los Angeles, California 90012, to consider any objections that may be filed and to determine whether the proposed settlement is fair, reasonable and adequate and should be finally approved, and to determine the amount of attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses to be paid to Class Counsel.
- 5) All memoranda, affidavits, declarations and other evidence in support of the request for final approval of the settlement and attorneys' fees and costs shall be filed within twenty-eight (28) calendar days prior to the above hearing.
