1. Judgment is hereby entered pursuant to the Final Approval Order of Class Action and PAGA Settlement.

2. The Parties are ordered to appear at 9:00 a.m. on April 25, 2024 for a compliance hearing to report to the Court on the distributions to Class Members, the LWDA, Class Counsel, the Named Plaintiff, the cy pres beneficiary, and performance by the Settlement Administrator of other duties incumbent on it under the Settlement Agreement and Order of this Court.

3. Plaintiffs' counsel are to submit a compliance statement one week before the compliance hearing date.

4. Five percent of the attorney's fees are to be withheld by the claims administrator pending satisfactory compliance as found by the Court.

5. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 384(b), after the settlement is completely implemented, this judgment must be amended to reflect the amount paid to the cy pres recipient.

6. The Court retains continuing jurisdiction to enforce the Settlement pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.769(h), even after the entry of judgment based thereon. Without affecting the finality of the Settlement or Judgment entered, this Court shall retain exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the action and the Parties, including all Settlement Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the Settlement.
