On April 3, 2024, this Court granted final approval to the class settlement and entered its Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Final Approval Order").

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this Court's Final Approval Order.
 - 2. The Class is defined as the following:

Defendant.

The Plaintiff Class is defined as follows: all drivers who have performed at least one Vehicle Transport for Defendant in California while being classified by Defendant as an independent contractor at any time from November 18, 2018 to August 31, 2023.

The Aggrieved Class Members are Class Members who performed at least one Vehicle Transport for Defendant in California, while being classified by Defendant as an independent contractor, at any time from November 10, 2021 to August 31, 2023.

- 3. The Class Representative and each Settlement Class member who have not properly excluded themselves shall take nothing from their complaint in this action except as set forth in (i) the Final Approval Order; (ii) Settlement Agreement; and (iii) the Order Granting Motion for Approval of Attorney's Fees and Costs, also filed April 3, 2024.
- 4. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, section 664.6 of the California Code of Civil Procedure, and rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court, this Court retains jurisdiction over the Class Representative, each Class Member who has not properly excluded themselves, and defendant, to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Final Approval Order, and this Judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
