1 **JUDGMENT**

2 Pursuant to the Order Granting the Motion for Final Approval of the Class Action Settlement
3 and Motion for Attorneys’ Fees, Costs and Expenses, and a Class Representative Enhancement Payment
4 (“Order”), it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** as follows:

5 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with, and incorporates by reference the
6 findings of, the Court’s Order and the Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release of Claims
7 (“Settlement Agreement”). Unless otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have
8 the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement.


9 2. As provided by the Order, all Class Members who did not timely and properly opt out
10 from the Settlement are barred from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any of the Released Claims, as
11 defined by the Settlement Agreement. Consistent with the definitions provided in the Settlement
12 Agreement, the Settlement Class consists of: All persons who worked for Defendant as non-exempt,
13 hourly paid employees in California at any time from November 22, 2015 through June 12, 2021.

14 3. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and
15 continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all Class Members, for
16 purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein.

17 4. This document shall constitute a judgment (and separate document constituting said
18 judgment) for purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h).
