2	In accordance with, and for the reasons stated in the Order Granting Final Approval of	
3	Class Action Settlement, judgment shall be entered whereby Plaintiff AGUSTIN CASTANEDA	
4	("Plaintiff") and all Settlement Class Members shall take nothing from Defendant HUNGRY MAN,	
5	INC. ("Defendant"), except as expressly set forth in the Revised Joint Stipulation of Class Action	
6	Settlement, which was previously filed as part of Plaintiff's Motion for Final Approval of Class Action	
7	Settlement, which was granted on April 11, 2022.	
8	1. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 and Rule 3.769(h) of the California	
9	Rules of Court, the Court reserves exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this Action, the Parties and	
10	the Class Members for the purposes of supervising:	
11	(a) the implementation, enforcement, construction, and interpretation of the Settlement, the	
12	Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, the plan of allocation, the	
13	Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, and the Judgment; and	
14	(b) distribution of amounts paid under this Settlement.	
15	2. The certified Class is defined as:	
16	"For the period from July 31, 2015 through and including October 5, 2021, all current	
17	and former nonexempt, hourly paid employees employed by Defendant in California	
18	(such persons are referred to as "Class Members," and such period is referred to hereafter	
19	as the "Class Period")."	
20	3. Plaintiff and all the Class Members who have not submitted a valid and timely Request	
21	for Exclusion (and so who are not Opt Outs), shall be deemed conclusively to have made the following	
22	releases set forth in Paragraphs in § I. P. of the Settlement, which shall have the force and effect of res	
23	judicata as to each of them:

25	have been alleged against any of the Released Parties, arising out of the facts asserted in

27	claims, damages (of any kind), statutory penalties, and civil penalties for any violations	
28	of the California Labor Code governing: meal and rest breaks; unpaid wages, including	

minimum wages, regular wages, overtime, and double time wages; wage statement	
violations; failure to maintain accurate records; separation pay violations; any and all	
theories for or related to the timing of payments; and failure to produce employment	
records.	
(Settlement, at 2-3, § I. P.) Released Parties are defined as:	
Defendant [Hungry Man, Inc.] and all of its past and present owners, officers, directors,	
shareholders, employees, agents, assigns, attorneys, insurers, brands and concepts, parent	
companies, subsidiaries, and affiliates, and their respective predecessors, successors,	
assigns, and any individual or entity that could be jointly liable with Defendant, without	
limitation.	
(Settlement, at 3, § I. Q.)
