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1           **PURSUANT TO THE ORDER GRANTING FINAL APPROVAL OF CLASS**  
2 **ACTION SETTLEMENT ENTERED ON 8/29, 2023, IT IS ORDERED,**  
3 **ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:**

4           1.       The Court, having received and considered the Joint Stipulation of Class Action  
5 Settlement (“Settlement”) of Plaintiff Vidali Aleman (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Moonlight  
6 Packing Corporation and Moonlight Packing Company, LLC (collectively “Defendants”),  
7 preliminarily approved by this court on January 26, 2023, has entered the Order for final approval  
8 of the Settlement between Plaintiff on behalf of herself and all other similarly situated employees,  
9 and Defendants. The Court granted preliminarily approval to the Settlement on January 26, 2023,  
10 and administration was successfully completed.

11           2.       The Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement (the “Settlement” or “Settlement  
12 Agreement”), shall be incorporated into this Judgment as though all terms are set forth in full. The  
13 capitalized terms in this Judgment shall have the meanings set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

14           3.       Judgment is entered pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement. All Class  
15 Members who did not timely opt out of the Settlement are subject to the terms of the Settlement  
16 Agreement. All Aggrieved Employees and the State of California are subject to the terms of the  
17 Settlement Agreement.

18           4.       There are 2,168 participating Settlement Class members, defined as “all current and  
19 former non-exempt packing employees who worked for Defendants in California at any time  
20 between May 4, 2016 and January 19, 2021.”

21           5.       The Court having entered an order granting Final Approval of this Stipulation  
22 hereby enters FINAL JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff and the Class Members in the amount of  
23 Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$900,000).

24           6.       Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and  
25 continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all Participating  
26 Class Members, for purposes of supervising, administering, implementing, enforcing, and  
27 interpreting the Settlement Agreement and the Final Approval Order.


