- 3. There shall be a second distribution of these remaining funds after the Claims Administrator, CPT Group, Inc., deducts its fee, which is not to exceed \$88,500.
- 4. This second distribution shall only go to those Participating Settlement Class Members who timely cashed their Settlement Payment checks during the first distribution, rather than going to all Participating Settlement Class Members.
- 5. On or before September 12, 2024, the Parties shall file a joint report or declaration with the Court that sets forth the total amount that was actually paid to the Participating Settlement Class Members who timely cashed their Round One and Round Two Settlement Payment checks, the total number of Participating Settlement Class Members who cashed Round One and Round Two checks (and the total amount of such checks), the number of Round Two checks returned as undeliverable (and the total amount of such checks), the number of Round Two checks voided due to not being timely cashed (and total amount of such checks),
