**JUDGMENT AFTER ENTRY OF ORDER
GRANTING FINAL APPROVAL OF
CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

1 Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this Court's Order Granting
2 Final Approval of Class Action Settlement.

3 The class is defined as: "All current and former Captains who provided services for
4 Defendant during the Settlement Period of December 1, 2017 through April 19, 2018."

5 Four members of the proposed Settlement Class validly requested exclusion: Nubia Maria
6 Edwards, Christian Lizardo, Timothy Chiu, and Anja Buckle. Additionally, the following four
7 individuals were identified as Settlement Group Members, however because current addresses
8 and social security numbers could not be located, they were removed from the Settlement Class:
9 Michelle Sepulveda, Ganesh Boetsch, Carlos Ramirez, and Monika Mencia.

10 The only Class Members entitled to payment pursuant to this Judgment are Settlement
11 Group Members.

12 The common fund generated by the settlement is \$300,000.00. Through its Final
13 Approval Order, the Court has authorized the following distributions from the common fund: (1)
14 \$100,000.00 for attorneys' fees; (2) \$6,982.37 for litigation costs; (3) \$37,500.00 to the Labor
15 and Workforce Development Agency; (4) \$11,900.00 to the administrator for the costs of
16 administration; (5) \$4,000.00 as an service award to Plaintiff. Accordingly, \$139,617.63 is
17 payable to the Settlement Group Members.

18 Defendant Zesty, Inc., itself or through the Settlement Administrator, shall send the
19 Settlement Group Members notice of the entry of judgment by mailed notice in substantially the
20 form of the proposed postcard attached as Exhibit A to the December 16, 2020 Supplemental
21 Declaration of Diana M. Khoury. The notice will be mailed within seven days of entry of
22 judgment.


23 Pursuant to the Stipulation, Code of Civil Procedure § 664.6, and California Rules of
24 Court, Rule 3.769(h), the Court retains exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the Litigation,
25 the Class Representative, the Settlement Class and Defendant Zesty, Inc. for the purposes of
26 supervising the implementation, enforcement, construction, administration and interpretation of
27 the Amended Stipulation of Settlement and Judgment.


