Defendant Allied Pilots Association ("APA") submits this Case Management Statement and Proposed Order pursuant to the Standing Order for All Judges of the Northern District of California and Civil Local Rule 16-9 and the Clerk's Notice of June 6, 2018, Docket No. 132.

APA's counsel attempted to confer with Plaintiffs' counsel regarding this statement but received no response. APA's counsel first contacted Plaintiffs' counsel by email on June 4, 2018. Thereafter, APA's counsel left multiple voicemails and sent multiple emails to Plaintiffs' counsel, including an e-mail on June 5, 2018, attaching a draft of a Joint Case Management Statement for his review and response. Plaintiffs' counsel did not respond to any of these communications. Consequently, APA submits this statement on behalf of itself rather than as a joint statement.

1. CURRENT STATUS OF CASE

Discovery was completed in this case on December 31, 2017.

On February 22, 2018, Defendant filed a motion in limine to exclude certain evidence. The motion was fully briefed as of March 15, 2018, and is set to be argued on June 21, 2018.

APA believes that its motion, if granted, would substantially reduce the scope of the trial in this matter by excluding evidence of a long history of events that APA contends is irrelevant to this claims in this case and more prejudicial than probative.

2. <u>SCHEDULING</u>

APA proposes the following schedule:

Pretrial Conference: One-hundred and twenty (120) days after the Court's resolution of the pending motion in limine.

Trial Date: To be set at Pretrial Conference.
