JUDGMENT

JUDGMENT

- 1. Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this Court's Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, Class Counsel's Attorney's Fees, Litigation Costs, and Class Representative Service Award ("Final Approval Order").
- 2. The Settlement Class is defined as "Plaintiff and all other individuals employed in California by Defendant in the positions of CEO (chief experience officers) and/or tour guides/drivers who provided transportation and guided tours in California from December 16, 2012 through August 29, 2018."
- 3. As set forth in the Court's Final Approval Order, no Class Members requested exclusion from the Settlement.
- 4. Plaintiffs and the Settlement Class shall take nothing from the Released Parties except as set forth in the Settlement.
- 5. The Court retains continuing jurisdiction over Plaintiff, Defendant, Class Members, the Action and the Settlement, including jurisdiction pursuant to C.C.P. § 664.6 and C.R.C. 3.769(h), solely for purposes of (a) enforcing the Settlement (including assuring that the settlement payments are made pursuant to the payment plan in the Settlement), (b) addressing settlement administration matters, and (c) addressing such post-Judgment matters as may be appropriate under court rules or applicable law.
- 6. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the total amount payable to all class members if all class members are paid the amount to which they are entitled pursuant to the judgment is \$84,000.
- 7. Notice of entry of this Judgment shall be provided to the Settlement Class by posting this Order and the final judgment on the administrator's website for a period of not less than 60 days from the date the judgment is entered. It shall not be necessary to send notice of the entry of this Judgment to the Settlement Class by any other means.
 - 8. This document shall constitute a judgment for the purposes of C.R.C. 3.769(h).
