The Court hears oral argument and confirms the tentative ruling as follows:

TENTATIVE RULING

Plaintiff Jeremy Manning's unopposed motion for preliminary approval of class action settlement is conditionally granted.

Plaintiff served a PAGA notice letter to the LWDA on November 22, 2017. Was the Reed first amended complaint served also, along with the settlement?

The motion suggests the class administrator will not need to do a skip trace. However, the settlement states, "the Claims Administrator shall undertake an Accurint or Experian Skip Tracing on the Class Member to attempt to ascertain the current address of the particular Class Member in question and, if such an address is ascertained, the Claims Administrator will re-send the Class Notice within three (3) business days of receipt of the returned Class Notice." (Settlement, §3.2.7.) The administrator shall do a skip trace on any unreturned notices.

Counsel shall file a declaration whether there were any uncashed checks and how much was given to the San Diego County Bar Foundation.

The Court confirms with counsel the final approval hearing has already been set for 04/09/2021 at 9:00A.M.
