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1 This matter, having come before the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for  
2 the County of Sacramento, at 2:00 p.m. on February 21, 2020 with Scott Cole & Associates, APC  
3 appearing as counsel for Representative Plaintiffs Maged Hakeem, Sherif Hakeem and Barbara  
4 Sanchez, individually and on behalf of the Plaintiff Class and Aggrieved Employees, and  
5 Martenson, Hasbrouck & Simon LLP appearing as counsel for defendant Universal Protection  
6 Service and Does 1 through 100 ("Defendants"). The Court, having carefully considered the briefs,  
7 argument of counsel and all matters presented to the Court and good cause appearing, hereby  
8 GRANTS Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement.

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**


11 1. The Court preliminarily approves the Settlement Agreement entitled "Allied  
12 Universal Security Services Wage and Hour Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release of  
13 Claims," including the parties' modifications thereto ("Settlement Agreement"), attached as  
14 Exhibit "A" to the Declaration of Scott Cole, Esq. in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary  
15 Approval of Modification to Settlement Agreement and Revised Class Notice ("Cole Decl."). This  
16 is based on the Court's determination that the Settlement is within the range of possible final  
17 approval.

18 2. The Court approves, both as to form and content, the Class Notice, attached to the  
19 Cole Decl. as Exhibit "B." The Class Notice shall be provided to class members in the manner set  
20 forth in the Settlement Agreement.

21 3. The final approval hearing shall be held on June 8, 2020 at  
22 2:00 P.M. in Department 53 of this Court, to determine whether the proposed Settlement  
23 is fair, adequate, reasonable, and should be granted final approval. At that time, the Court will also  
24 consider Plaintiffs' application for attorneys' fees, costs, settlement administration expenses, and  
25 service payments to the Class Representatives.
