IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Court preliminarily approves the Settlement Agreement entitled "Settlement Agreement and Release of Claims," attached as "Exhibit A" to the Declaration of Scott Edward Cole, Esq. in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Cole Decl."). 
